The Custer County Fair Board announces a scholarship opportunity for 4-H and FFA members in memory of our good friend Travis Roche. Travis was a pillar of the Mackay community, including the Custer County Fair, where he participated in the 4-H and FFA programs as a youth, and later by supporting his children with their market beef projects, or others by fixing electrical issues on the fairgrounds or supporting youth through the market animal sale. Travis will be greatly missed and this scholarship was created to honor the legacy that he left behind in Mackay.

One or more scholarships may be awarded each year. Scholarship(s) will be announced annually prior to the start of the 4-H & FFA Market Animal Sale held on Saturday of the Custer County Fair in Mackay.

Scholarship Information:

- Age requirement: High School Seniors or College Freshmen are eligible to apply for this scholarship (determined on January 1 of year scholarship is given out)
- Applicant can only win scholarship once.
- Applicant must be enrolled (or have been enrolled) and active in the Custer County 4-H program or Challis or Mackay FFA Chapter.
- If chosen, applicant must provide proof of college enrollment prior to receiving scholarship check.
- Applicant will be judged on:
 - Experience in 4-H & FFA projects and activities (30%)
 - Leadership, personal, community, civic activities, & work history (40%)
 - Need (25%)
 - Scholastic achievement (5%): Include a copy of your transcripts with completed application.
- **Completed applications are due by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, June 7, 2024** (applications must be received by this time/date) at the **University of Idaho Extension Office in Custer County.**
